VERONICA KNOX – AUTHOR BIO

Veronica Knox writes multi-layered stories under the name V KNOX that reconcile the romance of historical facts with imaginative fiction: eclectic historical fantasies, art history delivered in ghost stories, and time slip adventures for adult children of all ages.

Her **‘BEDE SERIES’** is a 4-book magical realism time-slip for ages 12 and up in which a disgruntled stately home nestled beside Hadrian’s wall (in the north of England) has a mind of its own in a mystical landscape that shelters a pair of teenagers, resident ghosts, mythical elementals, and sentient animals who explore Ancient Egypt and visit the face on Mars.

‘VIOLET SEABORN’S UNFINISHED SOUL’ her (2023) novel is an historical, supernatural, time-slip romance for readers 18 and older, set in the Highlands of Scotland about a mythical Water Horse during the 1918 flu epidemic that links to the Covid 19 outbreak of 2018.

As a member of the Shakespeare Oxford Fellowship and the De Vere Society, she explores a fanciful take on the ongoing controversial Shakespeare identity question. Veronica’s latest novel (2025) **‘SHAKESPEARE AT POOH CORNER’** is a whimsical tale of paranormal fiction about Lila Swann, a changeling six-year-old child who creates a fantasy world populated by characters from her favorite children’s books and the ghost of Edward de Vere, the true William Shakespeare. But after refusing to grow up as her friend Peter Pan advises her, Lila continues to age – a social outcast coping on the edge of madness until at age sixty-one a disembodied voice on a bus offers to restore the life she was meant to live in an enchanted scriptorium that teaches the three R’s: Reading, Righting, and Reincarnation.

Knox dips into the creative inner worlds of autistic savants and master artists, and in one case, the unknown child in the Titanic cemetery: **‘THE UNTHINKABLE SHOES’**.

By tapping metaphysical resources such as the discrepancies between reality and lucid dreams, Veronica fishes the depths of the subconscious, the afterlife, reincarnation, the anomalies of parallel lives and dimensions, and the classic psyche of ‘the ghostly lover’.

While studying for a Fine Arts degree in university Veronica discovered an imaginative take on art history and classical studies that led to other untapped avenues for stories. She learned inanimate objects are rarely bereft of life and portraits have juicy secrets to tell – snapshots of what was and more importantly, who left their ethereal ‘I was here’ imprint on the world.

What if two children aboard the Titanic were meant to marry, and a pair of baby shoes from an exhibit in a maritime museum could reunite them? What if the ‘Mona Lisa’ was Leonardo da Vinci’s kid sister? What if Winnie the Pooh knows who wrote the Shakespeare canon?

Veronica lives on Vancouver Island channeling ethereal echoes from objects in museums and the stifled voices of the Italian Renaissance – the artists as well as their anonymous subjects and companions. She grants them second chances to air their grievances, tell their stories, and together they set the dreariest history books on fire.
